The Isabella Plantation is open all year round.

FACILITIES

There are two toilets in the Plantation. One near Still Pond (open from April to November only) and one by Peg's Pond Gate toilet.



A project supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund has improved path surfaces and bridges, and installed more benches. Four trails of varying lengths have been marked and colour coded (see map overleaf).



GETTING THERE

There is a disabled user's car park at Peg's Pond Gate and buses (routes 85, K3) stop outside Richmond Park. The nearest bus stops are at Warren Road (Ladderstile Gate) and Robin Hood Gate, a one-mile walk on uneven ground.

SEASONAL TRANSPORT

From April to November there is a free bus service every Monday, Wednesday and Friday stopping at Richmond Park car parks and Isabella Plantation. Buses also stop at Ham Common crossroads (65 bus stop) and the barrier in Danebury Avenue, near Roehampton Gate.
